Culachy Wind Farm: Environmental Impact Assessment Scoping Report

Background and Context

- 1. Fred Olsen Renewables has submitted a scoping report for a wind farm at Culachy Estate, Fort Augustus, for 10 turbines of up to 220m BTH.
- 2.
