

# **Mountaineering Scotland**

## **MOUNTAIN SAFETY GROUP REMIT**

- (1) The purpose of the group is to monitor and review mountain safety strategy and collaborate on mountain safety issues in Scotland.
- (2) The group will consist of representatives from the following organisations:
  - The Mountaineering Scotland: Chair, Secretary, Mountain Safety Advisor, Chief Executive Officer, members' representative.
  - Scottish Mountain Rescue (SMR)
  - SportScotland Avalanche Information Service (SAIS)
  - Glenmore Lodge - SportScotland (GL)
  - Mountain Training Scotland (MTS)
  - Guides & Instructor Associations – AMI to represent

In addition the following organisations will be informed of group's business electronically and may attend meetings from time to time:

- British Mountaineering Council (BMC)
  - Mountain Training United Kingdom (MTUK)
  - Police Scotland
  - Mountain Weather Information Service (MWIS)
  - UK Search & Rescue
  - Scottish Advisory Panel for Outdoor Education
  - Scottish Cycling
  - Snowsport Scotland
  - St John Scotland
  - Visit Scotland
- (3) The group will achieve its aims by keeping the following under review—
    - (a) Mountain safety messages
    - (b) Mountaineering Scotland safety training courses and events content
    - (c) Specific safety issues as they arise
  - (3) The group will also act as a sounding board for Mountaineering Scotland officers and directors in relation to Mountaineering Scotland mountain safety work.
  - (4) The group will normally meet four times a year to conduct regular business and communicate electronically as required.
