HAZARD	RISK	AT RISK Speaker (S) Public (P)	PROBABILITY Low (L) Appreciable (A) High (H)	LEVEL Minor (M) Serious (S) Fatal (F)	MANAGEMENT	OK/AMEND
Travel to Venue	Road Traffic Accident (Specifically because lectures are held during the evenings in winter when it is dark and roads may have snow or ice on them).	S & P	L, A & H	M, S & F	Manage time so speakers have plenty of time to get to venue and have the option of overnight accommodation if appropriate.	
Fire	Risk of burns, smoke inhalation, death	S & P	L	M, S & F	Ensure all venue used comply with fire regulations. Point out fire exits/procedure to audience.	
Slips/trip hazards	Trip hazard over electric cables. Slips on wet floor	S & P	L	M	Ensure that all electric cables are suitably located to minimize risk. Ensure floor areas/surfaces are clean and clear of debris. Ensure steps are clearly marked.
